Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.279 dated 29.12.2013, under Sections 363, 366-A IPC registered at Police Station City Khanna, Khanna (Punjab) on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Raju alleging that his daughter had been enticed on the pretext of marriage by the petitioners.

Matter is stated to have been compromised.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the trial Court is satisfied that the parties have amicably resolved the dispute and compromised the matter, it will be open to the trial Court to give benefit of doubt to the petitioners and to acquit them in accordance with law.
