RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on 10.11.2014, petitioner was picked up from his house by the officials of CIA Staff and was taken to their office. On raising plea as to why he has been picked up, there was no answer from the police officials. Later on he was released when the family members and friends of the petitioner reached the office of CIA Staff. Further it has been alleged that the reason for his detention was not disclosed by the CIA staff despite repeated asking by the petitioner as well as by his elder brother. Precisely, in the context of constant

apprehension and threat to his life and liberty, petitioner has already moved a representation dated 13.11.2014 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.3. On the same line, a representation dated 9.3.2015 (Annexure P-2) has been sent to respondent No.2 as well.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass at this stage, there is no necessity of issuing any notice to the respondents. However, on the asking of Court, Mr. Arshdeep S. Kler, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State.

Three copies of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Respondent No.2 is directed to look into the allegations made by the petitioner and if he finds some incriminating material therein, then he should take all corrective steps in order to meet requirement of law.

Petition stands disposed of.
