SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 not to harass and humiliate the petitioners and their family members at the hands of respondents No.6 and 7.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that although no criminal case stands registered against them, they unnecessarily being called by the local police at the instance of respondents No.6 and 7.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the police that in case, the petitioners or any member of their family is required to be summoned for any enquiry, a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. be given to them.
