Anju Rani and Sawan Masih, wife and husband have moved this Court seeking protection on the ground that they have married on March 20, 2015 against the wishes of their parents and relatives.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners had moved an application (Annexure P-6) before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala to seek protection but no action has been taken by the Police.

In this view of the matter, Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala is directed to look into the application (Annexure P-6) and if there is any substance in it, may proceed further, in accordance with law.

The present order, however, shall not be deemed to be proof qua the factum/validity of their matrimonial alliance.
