Respondents No.4 and 5 Ranjit Singh and Nirmal Kaur, parents of petitioner No.1 Bhupinder Kaur have made an oral request that they want to meet their daughter. However, learned counsel for the petitioners, Mr. IPS Issar, Advocate submits that the girl is not ready to meet her parents and has rather shown his apprehension over the threat to life and personal liberty of the petitioners.

Keeping in view that there cannot be any effort for effecting compromise between the parties, the present petition in view of this adamant stand of the parties is disposed off with the direction to the official respondents to ensure the safety of life and

personal liberty of the petitioners and petitioners shall be at liberty to represent the official respondents in case they feel threat to their life and personal liberty upon which the official respondents would act within the framework of law without loss of time.

Petition stands disposed off.
