Petitioners, by way of instant petition, seek quashing of complaint as well as summoning order, however, without availing their equally efficacious alternative remedy of revision against the impugned summoning order.

Admittedly, petitioners have not availed their equally efficacious alternative remedy of revision against the impugned summoning order.

In view of the above, petitioners are relegated to their equally efficacious alternative remedy of revision against the impugned summoning order, at the first instance with liberty to the petitioners to approach this Court again by way of similar quashing petition, if necessity arises. It is also made clear that if the petitioners would file appropriate revision petition against the impugned summoning order within a period of one month from today, respondents shall not raise the issue of limitation against the petitioners.

Disposed of, accordingly.
