This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 420, 406 & 506 IPC at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur, vide FIR No.29 dated 2.3.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that petitioner has been falsely implicated. He is not required for the purpose of investigation. Thus, he deserves to be granted concession of pre-arrest bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and given careful thought to the facts of the case.

FIR was registered on statement of Dev Singh. He alleged that he paid Rs.7,20,000/- to the accused by selling his house. The accused thereafter purchased two vehicles out of the amount and refused

to repay the same. According to stand of the State, recovery is yet to be effected from the petitioner. Considering the facts and circumstances, no case for pre-arrest bail is made out.

Dismissed.
