The instant petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed by the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail in case First Information Report No.308 dated 31.10.2014, registered under Sections 316, 325, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

On instructions from ASI Prem Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner in compliance with the order dated 25.3.2015 passed by this Court, has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation as nothing remains to be recovered from her.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 25.3.2015, vide which the petitioner was allowed interim bail is made absolute. She shall abide by the conditions as enshrined in Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.
