The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.26 dated 07.03.2015 registered under Sections 61-(1)/14 of Excise Act at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

The petitioner was found in possession of 420 bottles of country made liquor.

The petitioner was granted interim protection vide order dated 25.03.2015 pursuant to which he has joined investigation, which fact has not been controverted by learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Gobind Singh.

Considering the aforesaid facts and noticing that the petitioner has since joined the investigation, the instant petition is allowed. The interim orders dated 25.03.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to condition that the petitioner would continue to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
