MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 212 dated 20.11.2014 registered under Sections 365, 341 IPC (148, 149, 323, 344, 364-A, 506 IPC added later on) at Police Station Nagina, District Mewat.

It is alleged by the complainant that the petitioner with few other persons had abducted his nephew Ali Mohd. after giving him beatings.

The said Ali Mohd. was recovered soon thereafter and his statement was recorded. It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that there is a marital dispute lurking in the background which is a reason for this FIR.

Learned counsel for the respondent would point out to the serious nature of the offence.

On due consideration of the matter and noticing the fact that the petitioner is in custody since November, 2014 and the fact that the kidnapped stands recovered as also the fact that the trial is likely to take some more time, instant petition is accepted. It is directed that the petitioner

be released on bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.P.C. Bail to the satisfaction of
learned Trial Court.

Nothing said herein shall be construed to be an expression on
the merits of the case.
