Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.31 dated 20.2.2015 registered under Sections 406, 408, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, Sadar Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that during the pendency of the present petition, he has the instructions to say that if both the accused-petitioners pay Rs.50,000/- more to the complainant, that will satisfy the claim of the complainant and he will make the statement for getting the present FIR quashed on the basis of compromise.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the above-said offer made by the learned counsel for the complainant is acceptable to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 25.3.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.

However, it is made clear that an amount of Rs.2.50 lacs,

deposited by the petitioner with the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court, in compliance of the order dated 25.3.2015 passed by this Court, shall be released in favour of respondent No.2 on the appropriate direction issued by this Court on quashing of the present FIR on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.
