Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.124 dated 16.12.2012 registered under Sections 307, 341, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act at P.S. Bilga, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the FIR in question was registered on 16.12.2014 involving total 10 persons, out of them one namely Ghona has expired. The allegation against the petitioner is that he fired a shot on the complainant but complainant escaped and fell down from the motorcycle. All the accused persons ran away from the spot. Petitioner is in custody

since 24.01.2013.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surinder Singh, states that now out of 24 witnesses, 2 of the prosecution witnesses have been examined and the case is fixed for 08.04.2015 for further evidence. He further states that petitioner is involved in other cases also.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the same complainant has lodged one more case against the petitioner and in all other cases, petitioner has already been granted bail. Petitioner is in custody since 24.01.2013 and other co-accused have since been granted bail.

Be that as it may, without adverting anything on merits of the case, petitioner is ordered to released on regular bail.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed.

Let the petitioner be enlarged on bail, subject to furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
