Petitioner-complainant aggrieved by the acquittal of the respondents has preferred this revision petition.

The case of the petitioner-complainant is that he had filed a complaint on the allegations that on 23.08.2007 at about 9.30 a.m., the respondents armed with deadly weapons alongwith JCB machine had removed the temple and idol of her ancestors and thus insulted the religious sentiments of the community of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that certain photographs produced by the petitioner stand admitted by the respondents showing the demolition of some construction of the temple.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the judgment passed by the Courts below.

In para 13 of the judgment of the trial Court as well as in para 13 of that of the lower Appellate Court, the contentions have

been dealt with by the courts below. With the assistance of learned counsel for the petitioner, I have also gone through the record. The mere admission regarding the existence of the status of the situation will not tantamount to confession of the respondents having damaged the building of the temple.

No ground is made out for interfering in the orders passed by the Courts below in the private complaint filed by the petitioner.

Dismissed.
