Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.502 dated 28.11.2014, registered at Police Station City Sonapat, District Sonapat, under Sections 365, 364-A, 354 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that complainant-Seema was previously married with the petitioner and during the subsistence of marriage, one daughter, who is alleged to have been kidnapped by the petitioner, was born. Learned counsel further contends that after selling his agricultural land in village Mahra vide registered sale

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deed dated 17.07.2013, the petitioner had purchased a house in favour of his wife-Seema vide registered sale deed no.5407 dated 18.07.2013 which has been later on sold by her to one Smt. Sakila. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner has been harassed by the complainant and implicated in a false case. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner has been behind bars since 04.12.2014 and now the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.
