After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners withdraws the instant petition, with liberty to raise all the contentions taken herein at the appropriate stage before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty aforesaid.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that personal appearance of petitioner No. 2-Chhinder Pal Kaur mother-in-law of complainant-Mandeep Kaur may be exempted before the trial Court as she is suffering from ailments like slip disc and cardiac.

As and when petitioner No. 2 files application seeking exemption from personal appearance before the trial Court along with medical record, the trial Court shall exempt her personal appearance after

obtaining following undertakings:-

- (i) that her advocate shall appear on her behalf on each and every date of hearing and the evidence recorded in her absence would be acceptable to her;
- (ii) that undertaking of her counsel to appear on each date of hearing to defend her case;
- (iii) that she will not dispute her identity and she will appear before the trial Court as and when directed by the Court.
