Petitioner seeks regular bail under in FIR No.31 dated 11.03.2014 registered under Sections 467, 468, 471, 465 IPC at Police Station Phase-8, Mohali, District S.A.S. Nagar Mohali.

The FIR was registered against Vikram Singh and four unknown persons. The investigation was conducted and aforesaid Vikram Singh found to be innocent, but in view of his disclosure statement name of petitioner along with others came to fore. One of the accused namely Karamjit Singh is still at large. Petitioner and others alleged to have moved application to GAMADA for grant of NOC, but no such NOC was granted by the GAMADA nor any overt act has been attributed to him. He has

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been attributed only on the statement of Vikram Singh, who has been found innocent.

Petitioner is in custody since 19.01.2015.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harpal Singh, states that challan has not been presented. There are two other cases against the petitioner in which he was granted bail.

Since the offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate and the trial Court may take some time to conclude.

Without commenting upon the merits of this case, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mohali.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
