This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioner in a case registered against her vide FIR No.496, dated 10.11.2013 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Tripri Town, Patiala, District Patiala.

Allegation against the petitioner is that she sold approximately 55 bighas of land belonging to her son and received ₹ 1 crore 15 lacs as consideration. FIR was registered on the complaint of the vendee namely Kulwinder Singh. Son of the petitioner is a prosecution witness against her. Admittedly, challan has been presented and trial is proceeding. Material witnesses are yet to be examined by the prosecution. Petitioner is incarcerated since January 16, 2015.

Keeping in view the fact that it is a magisterial trial which may take some time to conclude and period of incarceration of the petitioner, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. Thus, without

expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Patiala.
