Prayer made in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.66, dated 12.07.2014, under Sections 308, 323, 506, 427, 148, 149 and 201 IPC, registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur during the pendency of trial.

The petitioner has been attributed the injury on the right eyebrow of Gurjeet Singh, and that injury was simple in nature. It is contended that the petitioner is a student and his case is exactly similar to the role attributed by Harpreet Singh, co-accused who has been granted pre-arrest bail in CRM-M-27174 of 2014 decided by Coordinate Bench of this Court on 29.08.2014.

It is submitted that three of the persons were arrested in the case and they are on regular bail.

For the reasons stated here-in-above, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating /Arresting Officer on 14.05.2015 between 11.00 a.m to 2.00 p.m. and cooperate with the investigation and keep on joining as and when required. He will also abide the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

In case the petitioner fails to comply with the aforesaid stipulation, the concession granted to him shall stand automatically vacated.
