FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 07.04.2014 sent by the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Fazilka has been received, whereby, after recording statement of petitioners Ravinder Singh, Davinder Singh, Amritpal Singh, Surjit Singh and Rajvir Singh as well as of complainant Bohar Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that there was only quarrel between the parties and that the parties are from the same very village and that this compromise will go a long way to remove ill-will and hatred between the parties and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.16 dated 11.02.2013 under Sections 324,323,148,149,506 IPC registered at Police Station

Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

Petition stands disposed off.
