Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Kirpal Singh alleging that the petitioner along with Balaur Singh, Pargat Singh and Hardeep Singh had persuaded him to pay money of Rs.71,35,000/-. Few sale deeds having already been executed, petitioner allegedly duped the complainant for a sum of Rs.22 lacs.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant has also filed a suit of recovery of Rs.22 lacs.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 27.07.2014.

In view of period of detention suffered by the petitioner, second application for regular bail can be allowed, earlier having been withdrawn on 06.01.2015.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that petitioner will not leave India without the permission of the Court and will surrender his passport if he is holder of the same. In case, he does not hold passport, he will furnish an affidavit in that context.
