The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.132 dated 11.9.2013 under Sections 406, 420 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Phase-II, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the allegation against the present petitioner was with regard to having induced the complainant to part with a sum of Rs.30 lacs.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 6.4.2015 counsel for the petitioner had sought time to complete instructions as regards willingness of the petitioner to pay back to the complainant the disputed amount in pursuance to any compromise that may have been effected. Accordingly, the matter was deferred to today i.e. 9.4.2015.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has produced in Court today a demand draft for Rs.10 lacs in favour of the complainant namely Harpal Singh son of Mehar Singh and drawn on Punjab National Bank, Basantpura. Counsel further states that the balance amount of Rs.20

lacs would be paid positively to the complainant within a period of three months from today.

Such offer is acceptable to learned counsel for the complainant.

Accordingly, the demand draft of Rs.10 lacs has been handed over to the complainant Harpal Singh, who is present in Court today.

In pursuance to such consensus and agreement having been arrived at, the present petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M., Mohali.

It is, however, made clear that in case the petitioner fails to make balance payment of Rs.20 lacs to the complainant by way of a bank draft within the afore-noticed stipulated time frame, the concession of bail being granted to the petitioner vide this order, shall stand withdrawn.

Disposed of.
