1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment?
2. To be referred to reporters or not?
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the Digest?

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482, Cr.P.C. is for quashing the order dated 23.8.2014 (Annexure P/3) whereby the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Moga has initiated P.O. proceedings against the petitioner, namely, *Sanjeev Kumar Mallhan*. The petitioner was declared P.O. and necessary intimation in this regard was sent to the SHO concerned and other police stations.

On March 26, this Court has passed the following orders:-

"Notice of motion to the respondents for 21.05.2015.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to surrender before Id. Jurisdictional Magistrate within a period of 10 days from today, who shall release him on interim bail at its satisfaction."

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant

to the order dated 26.03.2015, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial court and the trial court on 31.03.2015 while accepting the bail bonds of the petitioner, the petitioner has been released on interim bail.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has appeared before the trial court and has been admitted on interim bail, the order dated 26.03.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

It is made clear that nothing observed herein shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the learned trial court shall conduct the trial and decide the same on the basis of evidence available on record.

Petition is disposed of.
