This is a petition for quashing of FIR No.152 dated 13.12.2013, under Sections 447/430/427/511/506/148/149 IPC and 25/27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Rampura, Tehsil Phul, District Bhatinda on the basis of compromise. The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2- Jora Singh alleging that petitioners trespassed the fields of the complainant and damaged the crop.

As it is claimed that the matter has been compromised, parties were directed to appear before the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Rampura to get their statements recorded. After recording the statements of the parties, the learned Magistrate has sent a report to this Court regarding the matter having been compromised voluntarily, without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
