JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 46 dated February 13, 2015 under Sections 406, 498-A and 506 IPC , registered at Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar on the basis of compromise along-with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Report of learned trial Court has been received, in which, it has been mentioned that petitioner No.2-Gurbinder Singh did not turned up to get his statement recorded with regard to compromise. However, statement of complainant has been recorded in which he states that a compromise has been effected between them which is outcome of their free will and consent and without

any pressure.. He further submits that he does not want to proceed with the case further and has no objection in case the above-said FIR be quashed against both the accused. Even otherwise, matter involved in these proceedings is matrimonial in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in case reported as **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another; 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 46 dated February 13, 2015 under Sections 406, 498-A and 506 IPC , registered at Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same are quashed qua petitioners.
