Rekha and Naseem, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major and seek protection as they apprehend danger from respondents no. 4 to 6.

There is no plea that any of the party has converted. Petitioner No.1 is a Hindu and petitioner no.2 is a Muslim.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to approach respondent No.2 and present their representation. On doing so, respondent No.2 would be obligated to look into the grievance and take steps he deems fit strictly in accordance with law.
