Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.186 dated 26.07.2014, registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran, under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The recovery has already been effected from the co-accused. As per FIR, no one identified the petitioner, who is stated to have fled away from the spot. The petitioner has already joined the investigation. No useful purpose will be served by sending him to custody.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, the present petition is accepted and the order dated 27.03.2015, passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
