RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

Mr. Mahajan appearing for the management submits that the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement. He has produced a letter of the Manager on behalf of the petitioner-Company in which the dispute has been compromised for a sum of Rs.3,75,000/- as full and final settlement towards all dues. The statement of the legal heirs of the deceased workman have been recorded by the Court and there would be no difficulty for the monetary benefits passing on to them. The letter dated 1.9.2015 produced by Mr. Mahajan together with the photocopy of a draft and its receipt in a sum of Rs.3,75,000/- payable to Bedwati, wife of the deceased respondent are taken on record as Mark 'A' and 'B'.

In view of the settlement, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the impugned award of the Labour Court shall stand modified by the terms of the compromise.

Dismissed as infructuous in terms of the settlement.
