Report dated 5.5.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of the petitioners Paria Swami, Mutu Swami and Palni Swani as well as of complainant Anurag Sharma, Anil Sharma and Anmol Sharma it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.
