This is second petition under Section 438 CrPC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.212 dated 27.9.2014 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana.

On 28.4.2015, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to the condition that he deposits the total outstanding amount along with interest within 15 days from that day. It was second bail application and was entertained on the

condition that the petitioner will clear the entire outstanding amount. However, the petitioner has failed to clear the outstanding amount and therefore, the interim order dated 28.4.2015 has already come to an end.

Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.
