Trial Court report received, which shows that only the statements of respondent/complainant Kuljeet Singh has been recorded to the effect that the cheque of Rs.8,00,000/- handed over by the petitioner to the respondent is returned due to non-availability of the funds and the payment has not been made. The complainant has further stated that the compromise cannot be effected because of non-availability of the respondent.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition may be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file the fresh petition after satisfying the conditions of the compromise.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
