The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 123 dated 24.05.2014 registered at Police Station Siwani, District Bhiwani under Section 306/34 IPC.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that all the private witnesses have been examined and the petitioner is not related to the deceased and he was at his shop and initially the FIR was registered under Section 302 IPC but later on the facts emerged that Kailasho had not been murdered and it was a case of suicide. It is contended that the petitioner is in custody for the last 11 months and the trial is taking long time to conclude.

The deceased had died on account of burn injuries. The petitioner is in custody for the last 11 months. Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial is taking time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
