This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.51, dated 26.02.2015 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 384 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sushant Lok, Gurgaon.

The allegations against the petitioner are that petitioner along with other boys came on motorcycles and car for illegal extortion from the rehri in Kahnai colony. Upon resistance of the rehriwalas, they started beating the complainant party. During this process, the petitioner also suffered injuries on his head and fell down and other boys ran away leaving behind their motor cycles make Honda CD Delux colour black bearing registration No.HR-51-AL-8571 and Bullet motorcycle colour red bearing registration No.DL-4S-CE-8704.

Keeping in view the fact that there are serious allegations against the petitioner, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
