Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.16 dated 21.2.2015 registered under Sections 323/341/506 and Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code added subsequently at Police Station Kiratpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no injury was caused by the petitioner and he has been falsely implicated. He also places reliance on an affidavit (Annexure P-2) sworn in by Sarwan Singh who was accompanying the deceased. He prays for allowing the present petition.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after careful perusal of the record of the case, particularly the FIR (Annexure P-1), this Court is of the considered opinion that the present case has not been found to be a fit case for anticipatory bail. It is so said because specific and direct allegations are there against the petitioner. He caused head injury to the deceased. Investigation is going on.

In view of the above, no case for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
