Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no specific allegation of demand of dowry against the petitioner, who is the father-in-law of deceased Nikku.

State counsel submits that there are serious allegations against the petitioner and other co-accused as they are being tried for the offence under Section 304-B of the Indian Penal Code.

It is mentioned in the FIR itself that when the father of the deceased reached her matrimonial home on the fateful day, the girl was found hanging, but her feet were touching the ground and her knees were bent.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition.
