MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for bail in terms thereof in case FIR No.16 dated 31.1.2015 under Section 306 IPC registered at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had contended that the petitioner is in no way connected with the offence and the only allegation against him is that he tried to force the deceased into employment by abandoning his earlier employment.

Noticing the aforesaid, interim protection was granted to the petitioner on 27.3.2015, pursuant to which he has joined the investigation which fact is not controverted by the learned counsel for the State.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the interim directions dated 27.3.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition allowed.
