Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.26 dated 06.03.2015 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Darshan Singh, Police Station Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib, submits that in compliance of the order dated 27.03.2015 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for the purpose of any further investigation.

However, learned counsel for the complainant opposes the instant petition.

In view of the above and without commenting anything further

on merits at this stage, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, present petition is allowed. Order dated 27.03.2015 is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
