This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for placing
on record.

Application is allowed as prayed for and Annexures P-8 and
P-9 are permitted to be taken on record.

Main Case

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in complaint case filed
by Balwinder Kaur.

The petitioner was summoned in a complaint case. He had filed
an application seeking exemption which was disallowed on 27.03.2015. He
was asked to appear before the trial Court and interim bail was allowed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had
appeared and was admitted to interim bail.

Learned counsel for the respondents urged that there was 7 other

cases against the petitioner and he had slapped the police official on duty and there is no material evidence to show that the petitioner was unwell when the application for exemption was moved.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the medical certificates and states that the petitioner was not well and undertakes that there would be no further default.

The petitioner has put in appearance before the trial Court and undertaking has been given that he would be careful in future and would not be absent again.

In view of the undertaking, the order dated 27.03.2015 is made absolute on the condition that there would be no further default nor any prayer for exemption shall be moved.

Petition is disposed of.
