Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of grounds mentioned in application, delay of 60 days in filing the revision is condoned.

Allowed.

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Instant criminal revision has been filed impugning the orders dated 23.07.2014 and 16.08.2014 passed by the Principal Magistrate,

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Juvenile Justice Board, Gurgaon and Additional Sessions Judge, Gurgaon whereby application for bail moved by the petitioner in FIR No.328 dated 24.06.2014, registered at Police Station Kherki Daula, Gurgaon, under Sections 364, 377 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, has been dismissed.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a juvenile and his date of birth is 10.12.1997. The petitioner has been facing the trial before the Juvenile Justice Board. Learned counsel further contends that father of the petitioner-juvenile is ready to take care of the petitioner, if he is released on bail.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The impugned orders are set aside. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board/Duty Magistrate, Gurgaon.
