Challenge in this revision petition is to the order dated February 04, 2015 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala whereby, an application moved by prosecution for summoning the records i.e. original cheques (alleged to be forged) are lying in different courts and different files, which are to be proved in this case. The said application was dismissed solely on the ground that no reason has been unfolded by the prosecution as to why cheques in question are required by it and simply by saying that same are necessary for proper adjudication of the case does not serve any purpose.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to move a fresh application before learned trial Court detailing the particulars of cheques and reasons or the purpose for which the same are required to be produced, which shall be disposed of by learned trial Court after hearing the parties.
