After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners wants to withdraw the instant petition, however, prays that personal appearance of petitioners no.2 and 3 may be exempted before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

If petitioner no.2 moves an application seeking exemption from personal appearance before the trial Court, she shall be granted exemption from personal appearance, subject to her furnishing an undertaking before the trial Court that her counsel shall be present on her behalf and she will not raise any objection qua the evidence that may be recorded during her absence and would be present in trial Court as and

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when directed by it.

However, petitioner no.3 will be at liberty to move application seeking exemption from personal appearance, which shall be considered in accordance with law.
