Taking into consideration the facts that the petitioner has
suffered a long trial and approximately Rs.6 lacs of compensation having
been awarded by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal in favour of legal
heirs of the victim, the sentence of imprisonment under Section 304-A IPC
is reduced from the period of one year to nine months upholding the
conviction and the sentence of fine imposed thereunder. Conviction and
sentence of petitioner under Section 279 and 337 IPC are also upheld.

With the aforesaid modifications, the revision petition is
disposed of.
