Petitioner was working as a Secretary of respondent no.6-The Dulchi Majra Cooperative Society, District Ropar. For certain acts of embezzlement/misappropriation of funds, his services were terminated vide order dated 2.9.2005. The petitioner is stated to have challenged his termination order on various grounds by filing writ petition, which is stated to be pending before this Court.

By filing the present writ petition, the petitioner is seeking a direction to the official respondents/respondent nos.1 to 5 to initiated appropriate action against respondent nos.8 to 10 on the basis of some violations reported in the Audit report in the year 2007 as Annexure P-1 & P-2.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner at length, this Court is not inclined to issue a writ of Mandamus since the complete facts showing that disciplinary proceedings necessarily had to be initiated against

them any such violation have not been pointed out. Apart from the same, it necessarily has to be accepted that once investigations were being conducted the same would have been taken to their logical end by department itself. As such no case for issuance of Mandamus at the instance of the terminated employee is made out.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is hereby dismissed.
