RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the impugned orders were revisable and the revision petition was maintainable before the learned Sessions Court, he may be granted permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the learned Sessions Court, by way of revision petition, at the first instance.

The abovesaid prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is not contested by learned counsel for the respondents.

In view of the above, permission is granted. However, keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, learned trial Court shall not proceed with the matter for a period of two weeks from today, so as to enable the petitioner to file her revision petition before the learned Sessions Courts.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
