Petitioner has been convicted alongwith one another by the first Appellate Court for having been found in possession of a stolen car with changed number plate.

As the petitioner was not present at the time of final decision of the appeal, this revision petition is not maintainable till the petitioner is arrested or he voluntarily surrender to undergo the imprisonment as ordered by the lower Appellate Court. Opportunity was given to the petitioner to surrender before the Illaqa Magistrate.

Counsel informs that the petitioner has not surrendered. Counsel in such circumstances seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after the petitioner surrenders for undergoing the sentence awarded.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
