This revision petition has been filed against the concurrent conviction of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner states that apart from other facts, the entire payment has been made and the matter has been compromised with the son of the complainant.

Mr. VK Kaushal, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent and has accepted the factual assertions and states that he has no objection if the conviction of the petitioner is set aside.

In these circumstances, I find no reason to maintain the

conviction of the petitioner since both the parties have settled the dispute and the petitioner has already undergone two months of the imprisonment. Consequently, this revision petition is allowed, the judgments and order passed by the Courts below are set aside, and the petitioner be released forthwith if not required in any other case.
