The petitioner had approached the trial Court for release of the vehicle on supardari. An application had been dismissed by the Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar on the ground that the applicant is not the owner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the vehicle is registered in the name of Bakhtawar Singh who is present in the Court today and he had sold the vehicle to the petitioner and recovery of contraband was effected from the car which was parked in the house of the petitioner. She further states that proceedings have been initiated against him and the vehicle is lying in the police station.

Bakhtawar Singh is present in the Court today and he has filed an affidavit and ID papers. Bakhtawar Singh states that he had sold the vehicle to the petitioner.

In view of the above submissions, the petition is allowed

and the vehicle is ordered to be released on superdari to Sukchain Singh who is the purchaser of the vehicle. Bonds be furnished to the satisfaction of the trial Court/CJM Amritsar.
