Instant revision has been filed challenging the order dated 22.04.2015 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Rohtak whereby application moved by the petitioner under Section 319 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short, 'the Code') for summoning of private respondents as additional accused, has been dismissed.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has vehemently contended that in the statement of complainant-Vinod (PW 1), father of deceased, it has come that Sanjay, Payal, Raju and Nisha along with accused-Jyoti were also involved in harassing deceased-Naveen.

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I have considered the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner.

A relevant extract of alleged suicide note (Annexure P-2) reads as under:

*“I did not intentionally think anything wrong for Jyoti nor I did any wrong with her and what would I get by doing so rather Jyoti's family members who were giving me some favour would have gone against me.”*

Perusal of the impugned order dated 22.04.2015 reveals that the alleged suicide note has been considered by the trial Court. In the alleged suicide note, the deceased has blamed Jyoti and has also given some reference to his own parents. The deceased has not levelled any allegations against his in-laws, rather stated that they were doing some favour to him.

In these circumstances, no ground for interference is made out.

Dismissed.
