Heard the submissions made on either side.

The writ petitioner has challenged the qualification prescribed in the advertisement No. 2/2007 (Estt.I) issued by the Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh in the month of February 2007. During the pendency of the Original Application filed by the writ petitioner herein, an interim order was passed permitting the writ petitioner to take part in the selection process on provisional basis. The writ petitioner participated in the

selection process, but she could not get through the selection process.

Learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner would submit that the writ petitioner is not in a mood to challenge the selection of other candidates who appeared for selection along with her.

Inasmuch as the advertisement under challenge has now culminated in selection of the successful candidates who appeared before it and the writ petitioner who also participated in the selection process failed to clear the selection process, the writ petition, in our view, has become infructuous.

Therefore, the writ petition stands dismissed as infructuous, of-course, giving liberty to the writ petitioner to challenge the qualification that may be prescribed in the future advertisement given by Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh.
