Counsel for the respondents states that in view of the affidavit filed by Shri Ravinder Singh, Joint Asstt. Director (Legal), North West Sector, CRPF, Chandigarh dated 26.11.2014, the petitioner has been promoted as Head Constable w.e.f 26.11.2010 and has been granted financial gradation of ₹ 2800/- w.e.f 20.11.2011.

Counsel for the petitioner has stated that the substantive prayer of the petitioner has been granted but as per the petitioner, these benefits have to be given to him from a slightly earlier date. He prays that this writ petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous while granting

liberty to the petitioner to make a supplementary representation for the grant of benefits from an earlier date.

Counsel for the respondents has no objection.

No other argument has been raised.

Consequently, this writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with the liberty as stated above.
