Learned counsel for the petitioner, though has argued that the police has submitted the challan as provided under Section 173 Cr.P.C. and there is no allegation against the petitioner. It is only during the statement of PW5 Rani, the allegation of pelting stones to the complainant which hit her abdomen has come on record.

Considering the fact that PW5-Rani has made categorical statement, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition. However, he prays that the petitioner is an old lady and ready to face the trial and be protected by passing some appropriate directions.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the petitioner may appear before the trial Court within a week and shall be admitted to bail subject to furnishing of bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
